
# The Adventures of Bella & Harry:

## **Activities:**

- Have students create a journal pretending they are visiting Istanbul and have them document what they see and do.
- Look up and research different breeds of dogs.



- 5. Describe what you might be served at a Turkish breakfast. Menemen (eggs, onions, peppers and tomatoes), simit (bread topped with sesame seeds and shaped into a ring before baking), cheese, yogurt and honey.
