
# The Adventures of Bella & Harry:

- Have students create a journal pretending they are visiting Transylvania and have them document what they see and do.



8. What bridge was Harry afraid to walk across?

Harry was afraid to walk across the "Bridge of Lies" in Sibiu, Romania.

9. What food might someone eat during a visit to Transylvania?

Some typical dishes are "sarmale" (stuffed cabbage) with sour cream, "mici" (grilled minced/ground meat rolls), "mamaliga cu branza si smantana" (polenta with cheese and sour cream) and "papanasi" (fried cheese doughnuts) with sour cream and jam.

10. What are some things you remember about Peles Castle?

There are multiple correct answers: The Royal Family of Romania once lived there / it was the first castle in Romania to have electricity (lights), along with hot and cold water / it has many rooms including a Secret Passageway, Great Armory Room, Library, Grand Staircase and King's Apartment / it's a beautiful castle.


